Tasting Notes

Lively aromas of ripe blue fruit, allspice, blood orange peel and earth tones dazzle the nose. On the palate, distinctive notes of fresh baked blueberry cobbler and ripe strawberry are interlaced with hints of lavender, chocolate ganache, roasted almonds and lingering spicy notes on the finish.

Vintage Notes

The 2019 growing season began about two weeks earlier than usual. The Sonoma Coast experienced some rain followed by during flowering, cool temperatures allowed the grapes to mature gradually. Fruit ripened at lower sugars, thanks to the extended, cool growing season and produced Pinot Noir with complex flavors and balance.

Food Pairings

Enjoy this full-bodied wine with ripe and tangy cheeses, gourmet sandwiches, fresh seafood, barbecued pork ribs, slow-roasted stews or chocolate mousse for a sweet pairing.
